A replication agent is used to publish content from an author instance to a publish instance. Creating a reverse replication agent on preview server (B) is not necessary as reverse replication is not supported by AEM as a Cloud Service<sup>1</sup>. Creating a custom publish workflow (E) is also not necessary as workflows are handled by AEM Cloud Service automatically<sup>1</sup>.
