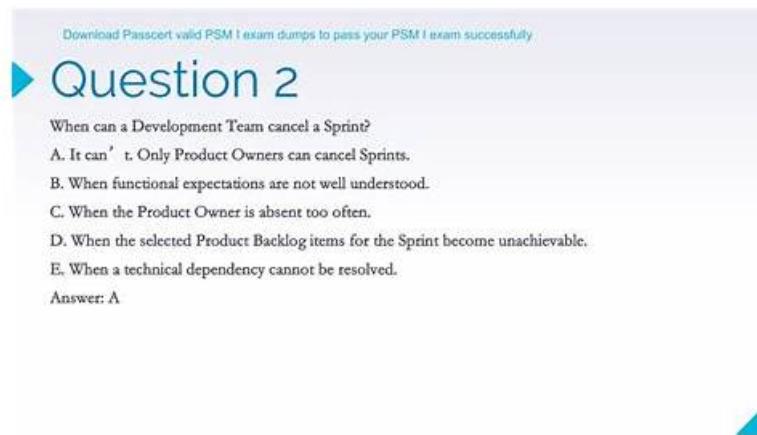

Professional Scrum Master I certification is intended for professionals who wish to demonstrate their expertise in Scrum and pursue a career as a Scrum Master.

The other options are outdated or incorrect. Option A was based on the previous version of the Scrum Guide, which suggested a range of 3 to 9 developers². Option B is too vague and does not account for the upper limit of team size. Option C is too specific and does not allow for flexibility.
