Topic 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Detailed Reporting Tool with Live Data: This section assesses the skills of an Advanced Report Developer and involves working with detailed reports that use live data feeds. It includes building customizable queries and using reporting tools to deliver real-time, actionable data to stakeholders.</li> </ul>
Topic 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Table Reports: This part measures the skills of a Data Analyst and involves creating, managing, and running Table Reports. It focuses on designing tabular data presentations that facilitate straightforward access to detailed workforce analytics information.</li> </ul>
Topic 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tile-Based Dashboard Framework: This domain targets a Dashboard Designer and covers building and managing tile-based dashboards. It encompasses creating tiles, assigning access, applying filters on dashboard data, and sharing dashboards to provide users with interactive and visually engaging insights.</li> </ul>


