


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To be eligible for the CompTIA 220-1102 exam, candidates are required to have at least 6 to 12 months of experience in IT support or related fields. Candidates who pass the exam will be recognized as CompTIA A+ certified professionals, who are equipped with the skills and knowledge to troubleshoot and maintain complex IT systems.
