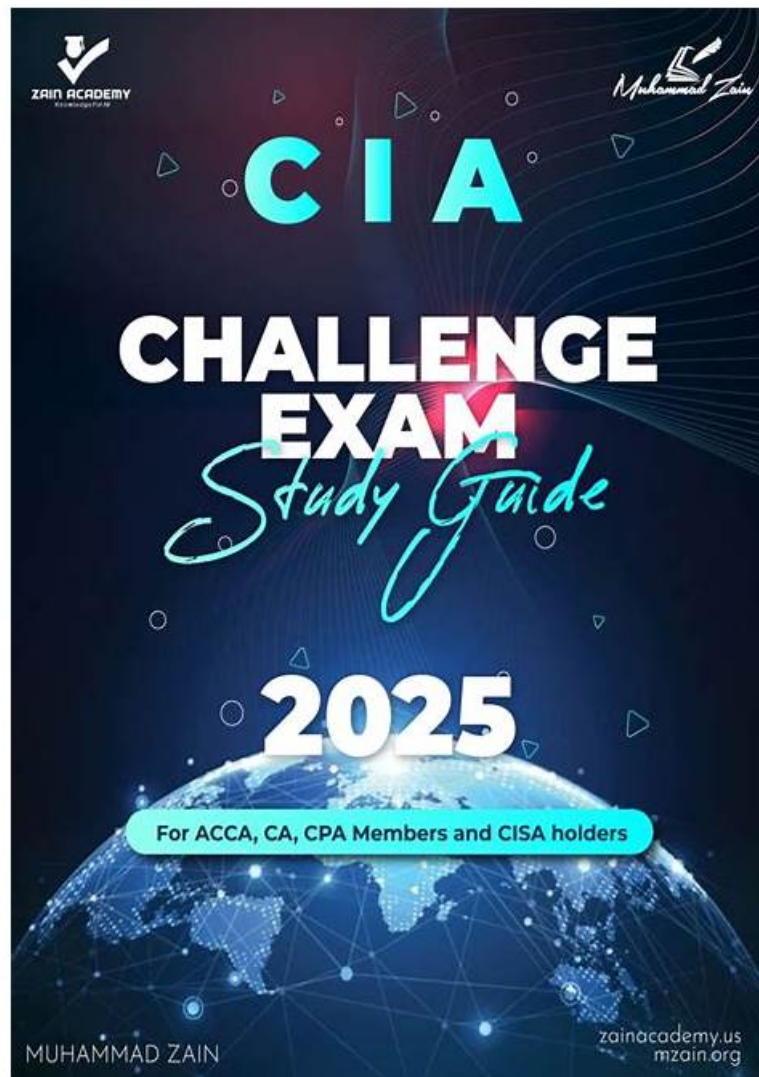

Topic	Details
Topic 1	• Project Overview, Roles and Responsibilities: This section of the exam measures the skills of an SAP Cloud Consultant and covers the fundamental understanding of SAP Activate methodology within the context of a cloud implementation project. Candidates are expected to be familiar with the project lifecycle, including phases such as Prepare, Explore, Realize, Deploy, and Run. This part also focuses on identifying key roles and responsibilities within a cloud project team, ensuring clarity in collaboration between consultants, clients, and SAP. It checks whether the consultant understands governance, stakeholder management, and the high-level structure of cloud deployment using SAP best practices.
Topic 2	• Field Configuration: This domain evaluates the knowledge of an SAP Deployment Specialist and focuses on customizing and configuring business fields in the SAP system according to client-specific needs. This includes adjusting system settings for master data, transaction data, and other essential field-level controls to support business processes effectively. The section tests the candidate's ability to use configuration tools, apply SAP standard templates, and ensure that the field configurations align with the desired operational workflows of the business. It also touches upon validation, testing, and documenting the configuration changes made during the implementation.
Topic 3	• Deploy and Migration: This part of the exam assesses the expertise of an SAP Deployment Specialist and focuses on the final deployment of the configured solution and the data migration process. Candidates should demonstrate a solid grasp of how to move configurations from a testing environment into production while minimizing disruption. It also includes knowledge of tools and strategies used for data extraction.

This class-based design supports consistent data models and inheritance in SAP Ariba's architecture.

Flex master data references require manual migration steps and are not migrated automatically during the initial template transfer (D).

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
