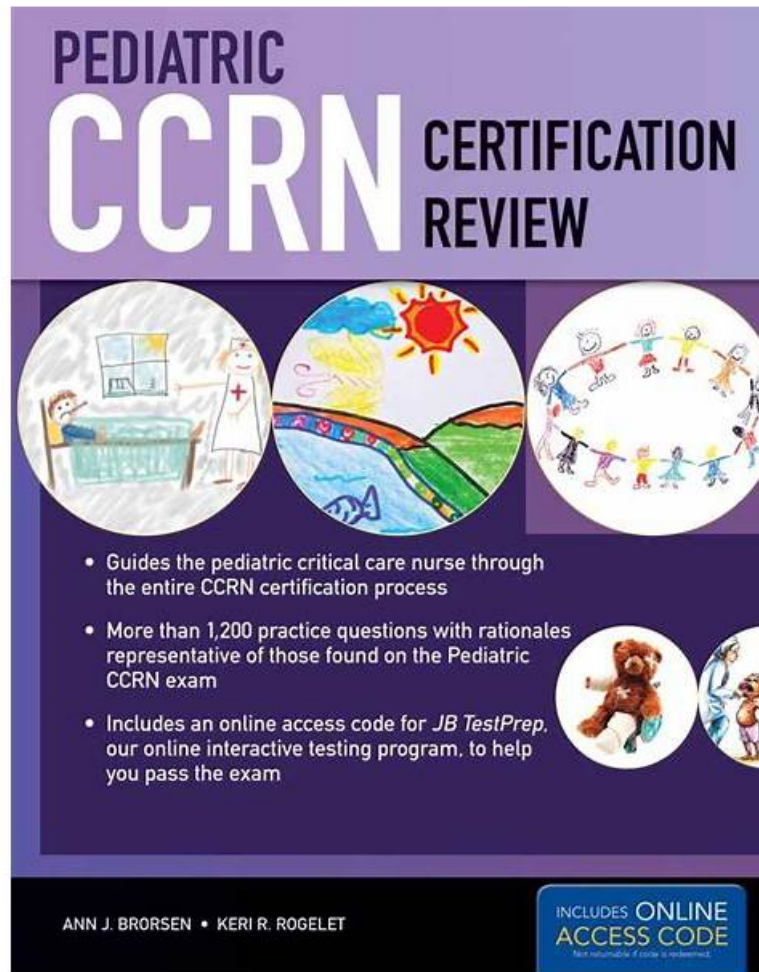

Lack of sleep such as from awakening the child at night for exercises is a stressor that can lead to exacerbation of juvenile rheumatoid arthritis.
