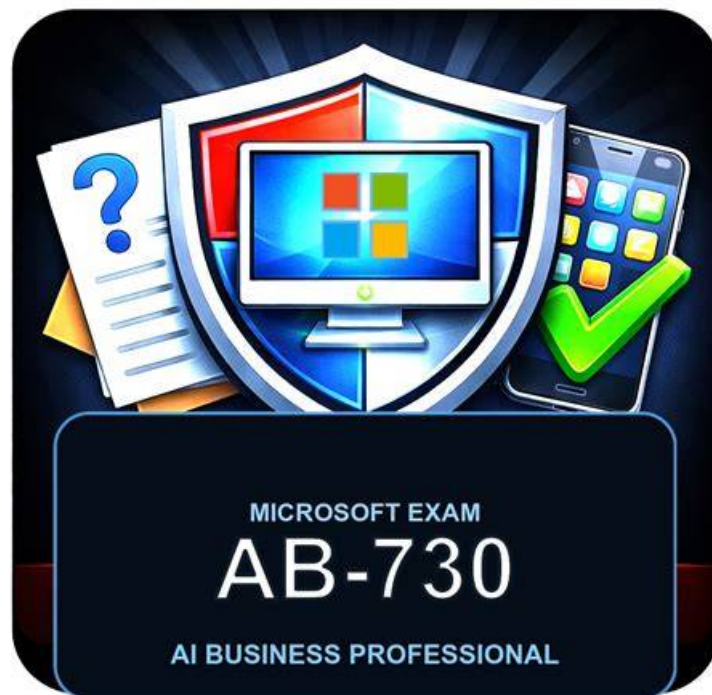

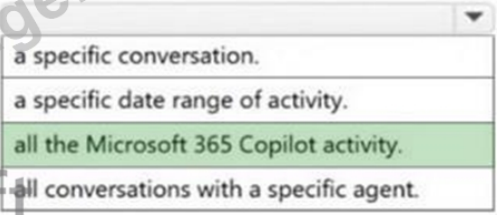

From the Microsoft 365 My Account portal, if you select Delete history for the Copilot activity history, you can delete _____. In the Microsoft 365 My Account portal, selecting Delete history for Copilot activity history allows you to delete your entire interaction history across all integrated Microsoft 365 apps.

Specific details of what can be deleted include:

Prompts and Responses: All previous user prompts and the corresponding AI-generated responses from past sessions are removed.

Cross-App Activity: History is cleared across the entire ecosystem, including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Teams, Forms, Loop, Planner, and Whiteboard.

Copilot Chat History: All recent conversations within the Microsoft 365 Copilot Chat interface.

Important Notes:

No Selective Deletion: You cannot choose to delete history for only a specific app (e.g., just Word); it is an all-or-nothing action for the selected Copilot category.

Saved Content Remains: Any content Copilot helped create that you have already saved within a file (like a PowerPoint slide or Word paragraph) will not be deleted.

Processing Time: While the request is sent immediately, it can take anywhere from 30 seconds to 15 minutes for the history to fully disappear from all apps.

To access this, navigate to your Microsoft My Account Privacy Dashboard > Settings & Privacy > Privacy > Copilot activity history.

Selecting Delete history from the Microsoft 365 My Account portal performs a bulk deletion across all Microsoft 365 apps rather than letting you pick a specific agent.

To generate an effective monthly summary with Copilot in Excel, Microsoft prompting guidance emphasizes two core elements: clear intent and expected output structure. First, you should state the goal explicitly- such as "summarize total sales by month based on OrderDate and Amount, and highlight month-over-month changes." This directs Copilot to the correct aggregation and analysis behavior (Option D).

Second, specifying the desired format improves usability and reduces ambiguity. For example, requesting "a table with Month, Total Sales, Number of Orders, and Average Order Value" or "a bulleted executive summary plus a small summary table" ensures Copilot

returns results in a format you can immediately use (Option A).

A specific cell range (Option B) is usually unnecessary when the data is already in a recognized Excel table, because Copilot can work from the table context. The workbook file name (Option C) does not help analysis.

Providing a formula (Option E) is not required because Copilot can compute monthly totals; formulas are optional if you want a specific calculation method, but they are not the best prompt ingredients for an effective summary.

Therefore, the best answers are A and D.

Saved prompts in Microsoft 365 Copilot Prompt Gallery are designed to be reusable templates for common tasks. Microsoft guidance indicates that users can manage these prompts similarly to other reusable assets- this includes editing metadata and removing them when no longer needed.

Option A is correct because users can update the title of a saved prompt to improve clarity, organization, or discoverability within the Prompt Gallery. This is part of basic prompt management.

Option E is also correct because users can delete or remove saved prompts from the Prompt Gallery if they are outdated or no longer relevant.

Option B is incorrect because prompts are not directly shared to Teams as a native feature; they are typically shared via the Prompt Gallery or copied manually. Option C is incorrect in this context because saved prompts are generally treated as reusable templates rather than being directly edited in-place (you typically create a new version). Option D is incorrect because scheduling prompts is not a standard capability of saved prompts in Microsoft 365 Copilot.

Therefore, the correct answers are A and E .

Microsoft 365 Copilot operates within the security, compliance, and identity boundaries of a Microsoft 365 tenant. Shared prompts, prompt links, and Copilot artifacts are governed by organizational access controls and tenant isolation. If a prompt is created and shared from outside your organization, cross-tenant access may not be supported depending on the sharing configuration and administrative policies.

When a user attempts to open a prompt that resides in another organization's tenant without proper cross- tenant sharing permissions, Copilot cannot locate or validate the resource within the user's own environment.

As a result, the system displays a "Prompt not found" message.

Option B would typically result in an access or permissions error rather than the prompt being unavailable entirely. Sensitivity labels and scheduled prompts do not inherently cause a "not found" error. Therefore, the most likely cause is that the prompt exists outside your organization's tenant boundary and is not accessible to you.
