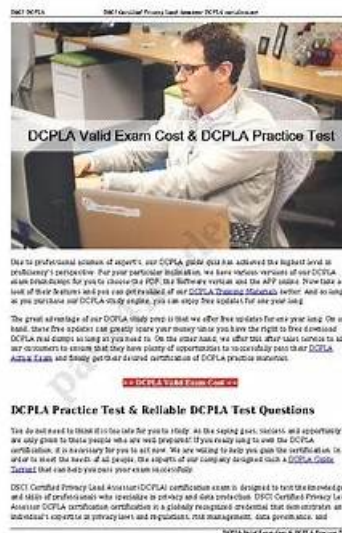

- * Password
- * Financial Information(such as bank account or credit card details)
- * Biometric Information(such as fingerprints, retina scans, etc.)
- * Medical Records and History

However, Sexual Orientation and Caste and Religious Beliefs are not explicitly included in the list of SPDI under Section 43A of the ITAA, 2008, though they may be protected under broader privacy considerations or sectoral regulations.

This classification helps in mandating appropriate security measures to protect such sensitive data, failure of which can result in compensation for damages to the affected individual due to negligence by the data processor or controller.

* Pseudonymization replaces identifiable fields within a data record with artificial identifiers. However, if additional information (mapping or lookup tables) exists, re-identification is possible.

* De-identification removes or masks identifiers, but residual or quasi-identifiers may still allow re-identification under certain conditions.

* Anonymization aims to irreversibly remove any link between the data and the identity of the subject, thus presenting the least risk of re-identification.

Therefore, when arranged in decreasing order of re-identification risk:

* Pseudonymization (highest risk)

* De-identification

* Anonymization (lowest risk)

This validates option A. I, II as correct.
