Bill of lading - CORRECT ANSWER-A carrier's contract and receipt for goods the carrier agrees to transport from one place to another and to deliver to a designated person. In case of loss, damage, or delay, the bill of lading is the basis for filing freight claims.

Bonding - CORRECT ANSWER-A system that connects various pieces of conductive equipment together to keep them at the same potential. Static sparking cannot take place between objects that are the same potential.

Cantilever rack - CORRECT ANSWER-A specialized form of rack used for storing long
