Forty practices were scored as NOT MET, all on the Authorized Deficiency Corrections list. The OSC remediated 17 of those during closeout, leaving 23 practices still NOT MET. With 23 practices NOT MET, the OSC falls below this threshold. Therefore, the Lead Assessor must recommend a Fail, requiring remediation and reassessment.
