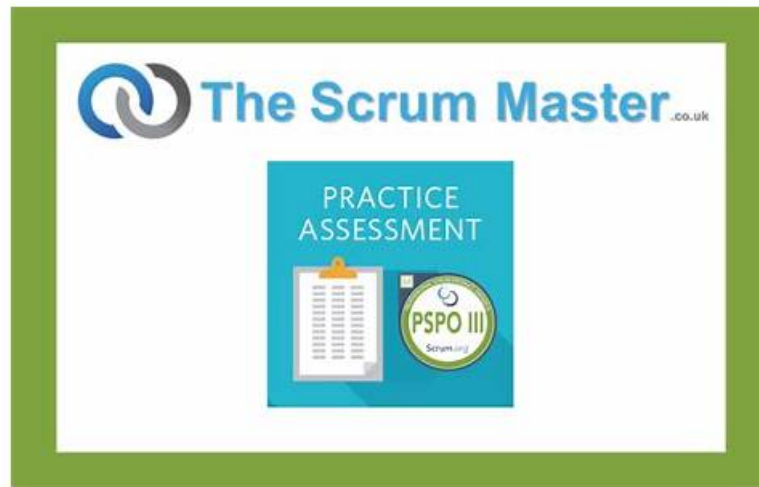

However, an Increment may be delivered to stakeholders prior to the end of the Sprint. The Sprint Review should never

be considered a gate to releasing value.
