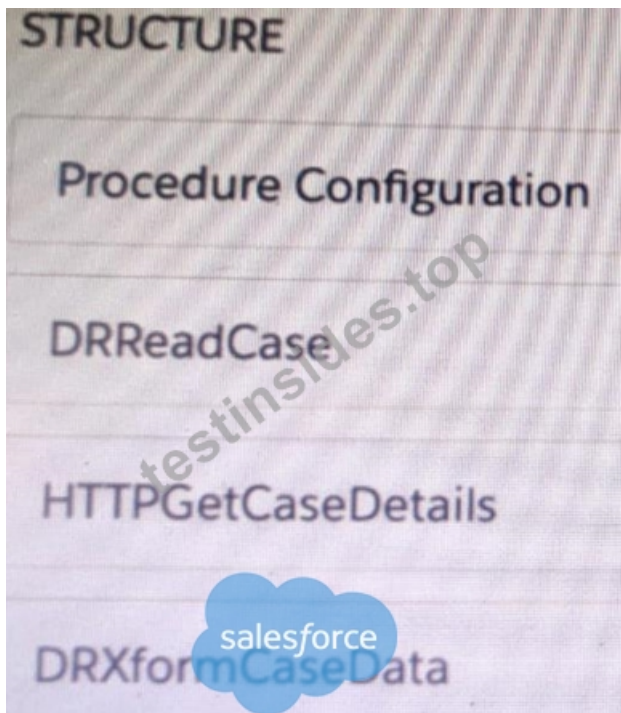

In option D, the Output Path is Current:CityState, which matches the Expected Output JSON. The other options have different Output Paths that do not match the Expected Output JSON.

Therefore, the correct answer is D.
