Topic 4	• Application and Data Security: This section of the exam measures skills of Cloud Security Analysts and explores how to defend applications and data from cyber threats. It introduces the MITRE ATT&CK framework, explains cloud attack patterns, and discusses mitigation strategies. Additionally, it covers web application firewall functions, lateral movement prevention, microsegmentation, and creating policies for secure application connectivity in multicloud environments.
Topic 5	• SAFE Key Structure: This section of the exam measures skills of Network Security Designers and focuses on the SAFE framework's key structural elements. It includes understanding 'Places in the Network'—the different network zones—and defining 'Secure Domains' to organize security policy implementation effectively.
Topic 6	• Industry Security Frameworks: This section of the exam measures the skills of Cybersecurity Governance Professionals and introduces major industry frameworks such as NIST, CISA, and DISA. These frameworks guide best practices and compliance in designing secure systems and managing cloud environments responsibly.
