Visibility conditions control whether the field is displayed, not whether it is required at publish. Validity conditions enforce value correctness but not presence at publish time. This feature enhances data completeness at critical lifecycle points.

Discarding unrelated packages (A) or publishing form templates (D) is unrelated or unnecessary for field migration workflows; fields and forms are handled separately. SAP best practices emphasize preparing all referenced master data and resource files to ensure smooth and error-free field migration.
