It is typically written from the perspective of an end user and follows the format: "As a <role>, I want

<something>, so that <benefit>". User Stories are the primary elements of the Team Backlog and are used to plan and execute the Iteration. User Stories should be small enough to be completed within one Iteration, which is usually two weeks long. If a User Story is too large or complex, it should be split into smaller stories that can fit within the Iteration timebox.
