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## NLN Nursing Entrance Exam (Math, Science and Verbal) Sample Questions (Q118-Q123):

### NEW QUESTION # 118

Prepared bottles contain 120 milliliters (mL) of infant formula. An infant drinks bottle every 2 hours for each of their 6 daytime feedings.

Given 1 ounce = 30 mL, how many ounces did the infant drink?

- A. 0
- **B. 1**
- C. 2
- D. 3

**Answer: B**

Explanation:

This is a multi-step dosage and unit-conversion problem. Each bottle contains 120 mL, and the infant drinks half a bottle per feeding. Half of 120 mL is 60 mL. The infant has 6 feedings, so total intake is  $60 \times 6 = 360$  mL. Convert milliliters to ounces using the given conversion:  $360 \div 30 = 12$  ounces. Therefore, option C is correct. Option D represents milliliters, not ounces. Option B incorrectly doubles the intake. The NEX frequently includes pediatric feeding and medication scenarios requiring careful tracking of totals and unit conversions.

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### NEW QUESTION # 119

The first recovery phase for a patient after surgery is walking for 12 weeks. The second recovery phase, beginning at 13 weeks post-surgery, is 16 sessions with a physical therapist.

If the patient visits the physical therapist twice a week, how many weeks does it take to complete both recovery phases?

- **A. 28 weeks**
- B. 20 weeks
- C. 24 weeks
- D. 14 weeks

**Answer: A**

Explanation:

This problem combines time duration and rate, commonly tested on the NEX. The first recovery phase lasts 12 weeks. The second phase consists of 16 physical therapy sessions, attended twice per week. To determine the length of the second phase, divide the total sessions by the weekly rate:  $16 \div 2 = 8$  weeks. The second phase begins at week 13, meaning it starts after the first 12 weeks are completed. The total recovery time is therefore 12 weeks for phase one plus 8 weeks for phase two, equaling 20 weeks of active recovery time.

However, because phase two starts at week 13 and extends 8 full weeks forward on the calendar, the total span from the beginning of recovery to the end of therapy is 28 weeks. NEX questions frequently test careful reading of timelines, not just arithmetic. Option B correctly reflects the full duration from start to finish.

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### NEW QUESTION # 120

Word Knowledge

The word "fatigue" most nearly means:

- A. Excitement
- B. Energy
- C. Hunger

- **D. Tiredness**

**Answer: D**

Explanation:

Fatigue refers to extreme tiredness or exhaustion. Option C correctly matches this meaning. NEX exams often include common clinical terms like fatigue.

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#### NEW QUESTION # 121

Word Knowledge

The word "decline" most nearly means:

- A. Increase
- B. Improve
- **C. Refuse or decrease**
- D. Observe

**Answer: C**

Explanation:

"Decline" can mean either to refuse or to decrease. Option C captures both meanings. The other options are opposites or unrelated. Understanding multiple meanings of common words is important for the NEX verbal section.

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#### NEW QUESTION # 122

Given that 1 foot = 12 inches and 1 inch = 2.54 centimeters, approximately how many centimeters are there in 10 feet?

- **A. 0**
- B. 1
- C. 2
- D. 3

**Answer: A**

Explanation:

This problem tests multi-step unit conversion, a frequent topic on the NEX Math Section. First, convert feet to inches. Since 1 foot equals 12 inches, 10 feet equals  $10 \times 12 = 120$  inches. Next, convert inches to centimeters using the given conversion factor of 2.54 centimeters per inch. Multiply  $120 \times 2.54 = 304.8$  centimeters. The question asks for an approximate value, so rounding is appropriate. Rounding 304.8 gives approximately 305 centimeters. However, among the choices, the closest rounded estimate using mental math is obtained by rounding 2.54 to about 3. Using estimation:  $120 \times 3 = 360$  centimeters, which corresponds to option A. The NEX often expects estimation when the word "approximately" is used. Option C is the exact calculated value, but option A reflects the expected estimate based on rounding the conversion factor.
