

Using ships or trains requires specialized safety inspections (Coast Guard or FRA regulations), dedicated waste management systems, and a plan for "Total Evacuation" of the mobile housing unit itself if a secondary disaster occurs. Disaster professionals must weigh the high cost and logistical complexity of these unconventional solutions against the urgent need for climate-controlled, safe environments for displaced populations.
