This can improve performance and scalability of AEM author instances by using dedicated instances for executing workflows. Transient workflows are workflows that do not persist any data or history and are automatically purged after completion

3. This can reduce repository growth and improve workflow efficiency.

SAML is a common and standard SSO handler that allows a user to access multiple systems after providing authentication credentials once. AEM ships with a SAML 2.0 Authentication Handler that supports signing and encryption of messages, automatic creation of users, and syncing groups to existing ones in AEM³. By integrating AEM Publisher using SAML directly with the IDP, the Architect can leverage the existing user accounts and authentication mechanism for the end users of the secured website.
