An inactive VM is mostly idle and not making meaningful use of its assigned resources. An over-provisioned VM is wasting capacity because it was allocated too much. A VM that is merely "consuming too much CPU" could be a bully VM or simply a busy VM, but that alone does not define the constrained classification. Nutanix uses the constrained label to signal a right-sizing opportunity in the direction of adding or adjusting resources, not reclaiming them. Therefore the most accurate answer is B, because constrained VMs are the ones that are short on sufficient resources for their workload behavior. ( Nutanix Portal )

That reduces risk during the migration window and avoids broad, unnecessary exposure of the container to an entire subnet. Opening the whole subnet might be convenient, but it creates more attack surface and more chance of accidental mounting from unauthorized systems. Since this is only for a temporary migration, the best practice is a tightly scoped NFS allowlist entry for one external host. That makes B the strongest operational and security choice.
