Constantino Lima Chávez, Líder Indianista aymara

La prensa del viernes 13 de febrero informó escuetamente de la decisión del gobierno del presidente Evo Morales de otorgar al líder indianista Constantino Lima Chávez, la condecoración del Cóndor de los Andes, el máximo reconocimiento que otorga el Estado a ciudadanos distinguidos por su servicio a la Nación.

La noticia publicada por La Razón (Sección Política A15) señala textual y lacónicamente:

“Un legislador recibe el Cóndor de los Andes. El gobierno del presidente Evo Morales condecoró ayer a Constantino Lima Chávez, el primer legislador indígena en Bolivia, con el Cóndor de los Andes en el Cuzco de Calallo. El encargado de imponer el reconocimiento fue el vicecanciller Hugo Fernández, quien dijo que Lima es una personalidad en el resurgimiento de las culturas indígenas en Bolivia”, según informó la gubernamental Agencia Boliviana de Informaciones.

Añó de escueta la información de la prensa escrita que poca importancia le dio a la nota de prensa difundida por AIB.

Aprovecho esta oportunidad para referirme a Constantino Lima Chávez, a quien conocí en 1982, en mi condición de director de la Biblioteca y Archivo del Museo Nacional de Etnografía y Folklore, responsable del programa que autodenominé “Antropología de Urgencia”, que no era otra cosa que la ejecución de misiones de campo para recoger registros in situ para el conformado de los Archivos Etnológicos de Bolivia. Esta nota tiene, entonces, algo de testimonial, con criterios muy personales, que comparto a raíz de esta condecoración que le otorga el Gobierno del presidente de Bolivia, Evo Morales.

Antes de empezar, debo mencionar que en ocasión de conmemorar el 61 Aniversario del Congreso Indígena (Mayo 10-15 de 1943), la Unidad de Investigaciones Históricas Ural-Pakana, la Biblioteca y Archivo Histórico del 11 Congreso Nacional y el Colegio Nacional de Historiadores de Bolivia, invitaron al historiador Roberto Choque Cangal, el sociólogo Esteban Ticona², el escritor



luis Antezana³ y un importante actor político aymara, Constantino Lima Chávez. Ese acto (realizado en mayo de 2006), muy modesto, pero de alto simbolismo, tenía el propósito de recordar a la sociedad el aporte de Constantino Lima al movimiento indianista de la década del 80, tiempos que no nos equivocamos, pues el gobierno del presidente Evo Morales reconoció con el Cóndor de los Andes esa histórica lucha que emprendió Constantino Lima Chávez y que hoy, a sus 75 años de edad, continúa sin tregua y sin pausa.

Volviendo al tema, a lo ya dicho por AIB por nuestra parte podemos mencionar que Constantino Lima Chávez (1933) fue algo más que un líder indígena aymara. Taka Mamani, ese era el nombre que empleaba en sus luchas políticas, fue un líder indianista santandradeño perseguido y enviado al exilio en el gobierno del dictador Hugo Bánzer (1974).

Fue uno de los primeros en propagar el nombre de Abya Yala para el continente americano. Así lo recuerda Mario Agreda:

“En el verano del 77 con el hermano aymara Taka Mamani (Constantino Lima) tuvimos largas charlas hasta el amanecer sobre la lucha que nos tocaba vivir, y me hace entrega de muchas páginas escritas de puro y letra sobre la historia del movimiento, todo les hora de su publicación y allí allora el contenido de la palabra. Abya Yala y me cuenta lo siguiente: ¿Cuál es la razón, de seguir llamando “América” a nuestro continente? Su verdadero nombre es Abya Yala, que significa Tierra de Vida madre tierra. América es un nombre impuesto, de aquellos que invadieron nuestro continente, pues este continente tiene su propio nombre desde siglos”.

No podemos olvidar su importante actuación durante su exilio, pues participó en todo foro posible para llevar su propuesta indianista. Por ejemplo, en la 8 Conferencia Internacional de Pueblos Indios (Kinur), en Suecia en Agosto de 1977.

“El Mallku Constantino Lima tuvo a su cargo la elaboración de la propuesta de Universidad Indígena que entonces

destacaba la necesidad de un sistema que evitase la negación a la educación superior de los indígenas, debido al racismo y a la discriminación existentes”.

Ese mismo año, en la Conferencia de las OPIAs sobre la Discriminación en el Continente Americano de 1977, se discutían las bases del Derecho Indígena por el Consejo del Tratado Indio, ampliamente controlado por los pueblos indios Sioux e Iroqueses, destacó la claridad del mensaje altamente político de Constantino Lima, quien “atacó acerbamente al parlarse de la Organización Internacional del Trabajo (OIT) a causa de la Convención –simulacionista No. 107 de la OIT que se ocupaba de los indios”. El representante indio norteamericano confesó entonces: “La mayoría de nosotros los de Norteamérica apenas si establecimos al tanto de que tal convención existiera”.

La OIT no tuvo más remedio que modificar su propuesta y de allí surgió la Convención No. 169 de la OIT. Se lo avanzado notablemente desde entonces, como se puede observar en la determinación del Estado de Bolivia para elevar a rango de ley de la República los 46 artículos de la Declaración de las Naciones Unidas sobre los Derechos Humanos de los Pueblos Indígenas, aprobada en la 62ª Sesión de la Asamblea General de la ONU, realizada en Nueva York el 13 de septiembre de 2007”.

A su retorno al país, fundó el Movimiento Indio Tupaj Katari AWTKA⁴ (con Luciano Tapia y Jalo Tumi, entre otros) en la comunidad de Las Piedras, en 1978. Con esa sigla participaron en las elecciones de 1978 y 1979, en el

The ORA-03172: STANDBY_MAX_DATA_DELAY error indicates that the real-time query on the physical standby database is

Increasing the network bandwidth (Option E) can enhance the speed at which redo data is transferred from the primary to the standby database, thereby reducing the likelihood of exceeding the STANDBY_MAX_DATA_DELAY threshold. Reducing I/O latency on the primary database's storage (Option B) ensures that redo data is generated and shipped more efficiently, further mitigating the risk of delay. These actions, focused on optimizing data transfer and processing speed, address the root causes of the ORA-03172 error in a synchronous Data Guard configuration operating in Maximum Availability mode.

However, with features like Application Continuity and the proper configuration of initialization parameters such as STANDBY_DB_PRESERVE_STATES, user sessions and current buffers may be preserved during role transitions such as a switchover or failover. Specifically, the STANDBY_DB_PRESERVE_STATES parameter can be set to preserve none, all, or only user sessions during such transitions. This ensures that in-flight transactions are not lost and that users do not experience disruptions during the role transitions of a physical standby database.
