Your employer is disposing of waste material in the Saskatchewan River. There are no specific regulations about this waste material, yet you feel this is placing the environment, and possibly the public, at risk. What is the first step your Association would advise you to take?

- a. Blow the whistle on your employer
- b. Report the concern to your Department Manager
- c. Report your employer to your Association
- d. Report your employer to the legal authority -ANSWER The most correct answer is b - to report the concern to your Department Manager.

How do we know this is most correct?

The question is asking us to choose a first step. Don't fall for the trap of deciding what's best for the environment.

A clue to the question is that we are not given many details. So there's not enough information available to reach out to an authority and report a wrongdoing.

Another clue is that blowing the whistle or reporting the act to an authority is used as a last resort. The literature teaches us to gather information or start a discussion first. So a tricky question since they used the word report to your Department Manager.

RED HOT EXAM TIP:

Realize that ethical dilemmas rarely have a correct answer. The literature teaches us to apply a method and step one of that method is information gathering and discussion.

Your organization manages a process where hazardous chemicals may be leached into the soil of a nearby town. This is due to improper practices by the Operations team, and

NEW QUESTION # 95

Professionals in the workplace can face ethically challenging situations. Common ethical issues are categorized to help the professional make decisions related to them. Which of the following issues is usually the least important ethical issue?

- A. Conflict of interest
- B. Duty to report
- C. Misconduct

Answer: D

NPPE ethics frameworks prioritize issues based on potential impact on the public interest and professional integrity. Conflict of interest (B) can undermine impartial judgment and public trust; duty to report (C) is critical where unsafe, unethical, or illegal practice threatens the public or environment; and misconduct (D) directly implicates professional discipline and can involve serious harm, dishonesty, or abuse of professional position. "Unfair compensation" (A), while a legitimate workplace concern, generally has the least direct connection to public safety and the core regulatory mandate compared to the other categories. Compensation disputes are typically addressed through employment practices, contracts, and labour standards rather than professional ethical duties-unless pay practices create conflicts, coercion, or incentives to compromise safety. In most NPPE-style prioritization, matters affecting safety, honesty, legality, and public protection outrank personal remuneration concerns. Therefore, A is usually the least important ethical issue among the options.

A licensed professional, living and practicing in the province of Ontario, is charged with a tort of negligence by a former client. Which system of law will be used in the judgement of this case?

- **A. Common law system**
- B. Public law system
- C. Civil law system
- D. Regulator law system

Negligence is a tort, and tort law in Ontario is part of the common law system (judge-made law developed through precedent), supplemented by statutes where applicable. Answer: B

Explanation:

NPPE ethics emphasizes compliance with law, due diligence, and protecting the public and environment.

Approaching a regulatory limit for a controlled pollutant is a foreseeable compliance and risk-management issue that must be addressed, not justified by improvements elsewhere. The best initial step is to inform the client promptly, document the concern, and collaborate on design or operational changes that reduce CO emissions with a comfortable margin below permitted limits (B). This aligns with professional obligations to provide competent advice, manage risk, and avoid creating a system that is vulnerable to exceedances due to variability, upsets, or measurement uncertainty. Option D is unacceptable because trading one regulated harm for another without ensuring compliance violates the duty to comply with environmental requirements. Option C is premature as an "initial" action; exemptions/variances are not a default solution and would not typically be sought before exploring feasible mitigation within the design. Option A is overly extreme and prescriptive; scaling back targets may be one option, but the initial professional response is to seek practical mitigation and ensure compliance rather than directing abandonment. Therefore, B is best.

Executives' personal assets (B) are generally protected by limited liability unless they provided personal guarantees, engaged in fraud, or statutory exceptions apply. The engineering regulator (D) is not a debt-collection mechanism; regulators oversee licensure and professional conduct, not repayment of corporate creditors.

Accordingly, creditors' primary recovery is from corporate assets (C).
