

"Assess" step, responders:

- * Check respirations
- * Provide lifesaving interventions such as rescue breaths if the patient is not breathing but has a pulse
- * Evaluate mentation (e.g., ability to follow commands)

Airway adjuncts and full transport do not happen at this stage. Scorecards and pediatric-specific modifications are addressed later in the protocol.

Assessing the airway is critical in overall trauma care but not the first priority in isolated extremity hemorrhage. Severity assessment is secondary to bleeding control.

Laundry detergent ingestion - especially in the case of liquid detergent pods - is associated with caustic airway and gastrointestinal injuries. The presence of crackles and drowsiness are signs of aspiration and possible respiratory failure. Vomiting increases the risk of aspiration pneumonitis, and esophageal perforation is a life-threatening complication from corrosive ingestion.

While seizure and hypoglycemia are possible complications of toxic ingestion, they are not as immediately linked to the detergent profile as airway injury and aspiration risk.

Pulse oximetry may be falsely normal in CO poisoning or poor perfusion. Skin color is subjective and not as sensitive or specific as neurological status.
