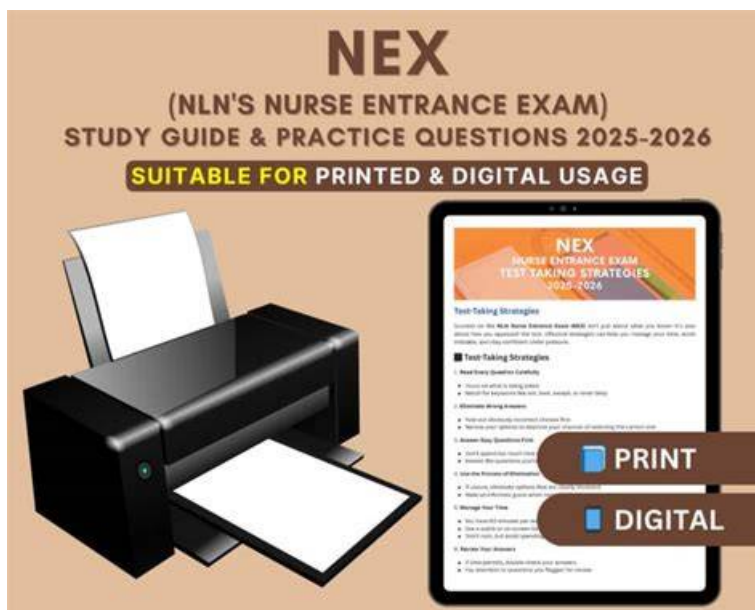

NEW QUESTION # 30

In order to neutralize a solution of HCl, one could add

Answer: B

Explanation:

Hydrochloric acid (HCl) is a strong acid. To neutralize an acid, a base must be added. Sodium hydroxide (NaOH) is a strong base that reacts with HCl to form water and a salt (sodium chloride). This neutralization reaction reduces the acidity of the solution. The other options-HNO₃, CH₃COOH, and H₂SO₄-are all acids and would increase acidity rather than neutralize it. The NEX Science exam often tests acid-base chemistry and emphasizes recognizing common acids and bases. Since NaOH is the only base listed, option C is correct.

Explanation:

For the 12-ounce cup: $\$3.00 \div 12 = \0.25 per ounce. For the 10-ounce cup: $\$2.50 \div 10 = \0.25 per ounce. For the 8-ounce cup: $\$2.40 \div 8 = \0.30 per ounce. The most expensive price per ounce is \$0.30, which corresponds to the 8-ounce cup. Therefore, option B is correct. The NEX frequently includes comparison problems that require calculating unit rates rather than comparing total prices. Always divide cost by quantity to ensure an accurate comparison.

These valves open to allow blood to move toward the heart and close to prevent blood from flowing backward. The structures indicated by the arrows in the image represent venous valves. Without these valves, blood could pool in the veins, leading to conditions such as varicose veins. Forward flow of blood is promoted, not prevented, by these valves. They do not obstruct blood flow under normal conditions, nor do they prevent blood from leaking into tissues—that function is related to capillary structure. The NEX Science exam frequently tests the functional significance of anatomical structures, and recognizing that venous valves prevent backflow of blood is a key cardiovascular concept.

The correct answer must be directly supported by the information in the passage. The passage clearly explains that sleep helps the brain process and store information, which is essential for memory consolidation. It also states that lack of sleep negatively affects cognitive abilities such as judgment and reaction time. Therefore, the conclusion that memory formation is affected by sleep is well supported. Option A is incorrect because the passage emphasizes mental and cognitive effects, not just physical health. Option C is directly contradicted by the passage's mention of impaired functioning due to lack of sleep. Option D exaggerates the information; while sleep affects academic performance, the passage does not claim it is the sole factor. On the NEX exam, supported-conclusion questions require selecting an answer that is neither too extreme nor unsupported by the passage.

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
