CHANGES TO UTT'S STUDENT WI-FI NETWORK

Please note that over the past year, UTT has upgraded its Wi-Fi service across all campuses to provide comprehensive wireless coverage for you, our most valued stakeholders.

To ensure that all students have adequate access to these Wi-Fi facilities, we have enhanced and implemented increased security on our Student Wi-Fi network (UTTSTUDENT). Effective 5th March, 2025, all students connecting to this Wi-Fi service will be required to authenticate using their UTT Student ID and Password.

Our GUEST Wi-Fi network will remain open, allowing you to connect without authentication. However, the UTTSTUDENT Wi-Fi network is specifically designed for student use and will therefore offer a more reliable and enhanced service, allowing you to effectively access all your required online student resources.

Instructions on how to connect and authenticate on the UTTSTUDENT Wi-Fi are provided below for the various devices, including Android, iOS and Windows.










A. Configuring your UTT Student Wireless on **ANDROID** Devices

Steps		Instructions	Examples
1		Go to Settings > Wi-Fi > Select the UTTSTUDENT network	
2		<p>You will be prompted for your Identity and password.</p> <p>a) Your identity is your Student ID which you can enter using any of the following formats (replacing “99999” with your actual Student ID):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 99999 • student/99999 • 99999@we.utt.edu.tt <p>b) Enter your Student Password</p>	
3	•	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click on CA Certificate and choose Don’t validate; • Ensure EAP Method is PEAP; and • Phase 2 authentication is MSCHAPV2 	
4		<p>**For some Android phones, you may need to type in the Anonymous identity which is:</p> <p>studentID@we.utt.edu.tt</p>	
5		<p>Click Connect.</p> <p>Congratulations!! You should now be connected to the Student Wi-Fi Network!</p>

Steps	Instructions	Examples
1	<p>1. Go to Settings > Wi-Fi > Select the UTTSTUDENT network</p>	
2	<p>You will be prompted for your Username and password.</p> <p>a) Your username is your Student ID which you can enter using any of the following formats (replacing “99999” with your actual Student ID):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 99999 • student/99999 • 99999@we.utt.edu.tt <p>b) Enter your Student Password</p>	
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Select Trust to accept the UTTSTUDENT Certificate 	
4	<p>Click Connect.</p> <p>Congratulations!! You should now be connected to the Student Wi-Fi Network!</p>	

C. Configuring your UTT Student Wireless on **Windows** Devices

Steps	Instructions	Examples
1	Click on the wireless icon on your Windows Taskbar	
2	Click on the UTTSTUDENT SSID, then click Connect (ensure that the Connect Automatically option is selected)	
3	<p>Connect with your Student ID and Password.</p> <p>c) Your username is your Student ID which you can enter using any of the following formats (replacing “99999” with your actual Student ID):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 99999 • student/99999 • 99999@we.utt.edu.tt <p>Enter your Student Password</p>	
4	Click Connect	
5	Congratulations!! You should now be connected to the Student Wi-Fi Network!
