We have an exciting new opportunity for students from the Caribbean to study a 2-year, distance learning Master's with a [Queen Elizabeth Commonwealth Scholarship \(QECS\)](#).

Fiji National University will be hosting an Interdisciplinary Master's in [Climate Change Mitigation and Resilience](#), exclusively for students from the Caribbean. As a distance learning award, this is a new offering which will allow students to become climate change specialists from the comfort of their own home.

This scholarship includes full tuition fees and a research support grant. Applications will close **9 July, 4:00 (UTC +1)**.

As a QECS scholar, your students will gain access to a unique network of like-minded scholars around the Commonwealth - including three other Climate Resilience Queen Elizabeth Commonwealth scholars. Through cultural exchange and academic collaboration, Queen Elizabeth Commonwealth Scholars help bring about positive change and find solutions to the shared challenges we face – both in their home countries and those that host them.

This scholarship will support the work of the [Commonwealth Climate Resilience Network](#). By providing an opportunity for scholars to take an active role in the network's activities, this opportunity will encourage the exchange of knowledge between the Pacific and Caribbean.
