- Have interest in public policy and generating new ideas or ideas for reform to key decision-makers.
- Be committed to engage in a network of likeminded youth.
- Have intermediate knowledge of English.

- Participate in a virtual leadership and public policy course with CAPP and IRI experts to generate relevant public policies on issues of importance to the Caribbean such as governance, economic development, climate change, education reform, and the digital economy.
