Re: UTTSG ELECTORIAL PROCESS FOR 2020-2021 TENURE

This document serves to inform UTT Students of the decision taken by The Executive Student Guild (ESG) at UTT on the matter of the general elections for Elected Officers of the Chapter Guild and the ESG of the 2020-2021 tenure.

The well-known COVID-19 pandemic caused the postponement of the said electoral process. This, coupled with several other hinderance continues to delay the process and in an effort to ensure continuity of the UTTSG it is imperative therefore, that urgent action be taken in this regard.

The Constitution of the UTTSG gives authority to the ESG President to appoint officers into the vacant position after a period of 4 months after the election date; Section 7: UTTSG Terms and Offices, section 7.3 Filling Vacant Positions. This is the basis of which this decision is being made as the 2020-2021 academic year is set to begin, the ESG made an executive decision to appoint these candidates into Elected Officer positions on each Chapter Guild from the pool of suitable candidates who submitted nominations in February 2020.
