We have received reports of staff members receiving an email with subject matter “View Attached Overdue Invoice” (or some other subject) that contains a hyperlink that when clicked on will take you to a phishing website and prompt you to enter your email address and password, as shown below.

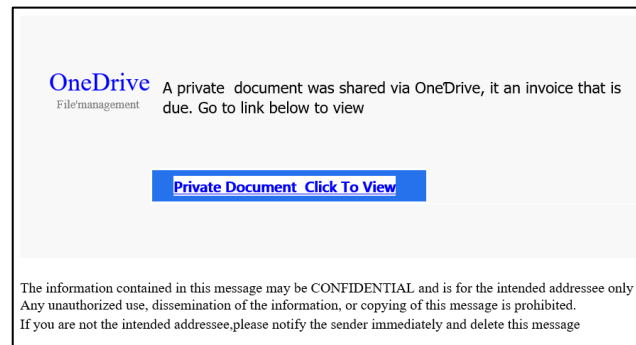


Figure 1. Phishing email

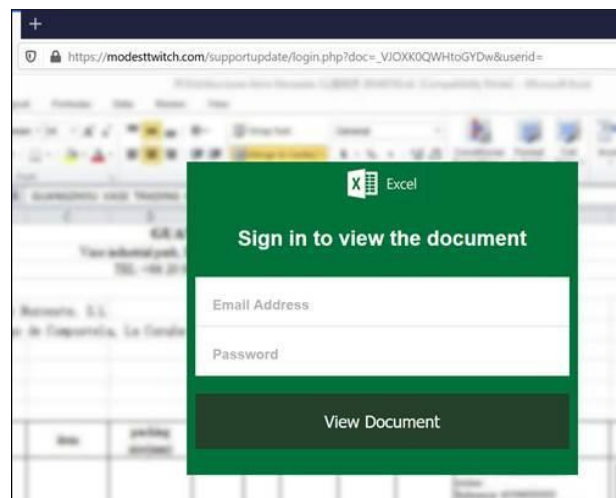


Figure 2: Phishing website

Please note that even if you received this email from a UTT member of staff it is still a **phishing email** that is attempting to steal your password.

**Do not click on any links in this email** but immediately report it using the “Report Message” option from your outlook client or simply delete the email

Most importantly - If you did click on the link and entered your email and password in this site **you should immediately change your password** by going to our My Campus website (<https://mycampus.utt.edu.tt>) and clicking on the “Reset Password” link.

You are reminded that, especially in this increasingly digital age, we need to be constantly vigilant when opening and reviewing emails - even from known email sources. When in doubt reach out to IT for further information. Don't be too anxious to click and give away your password to the phishers.
