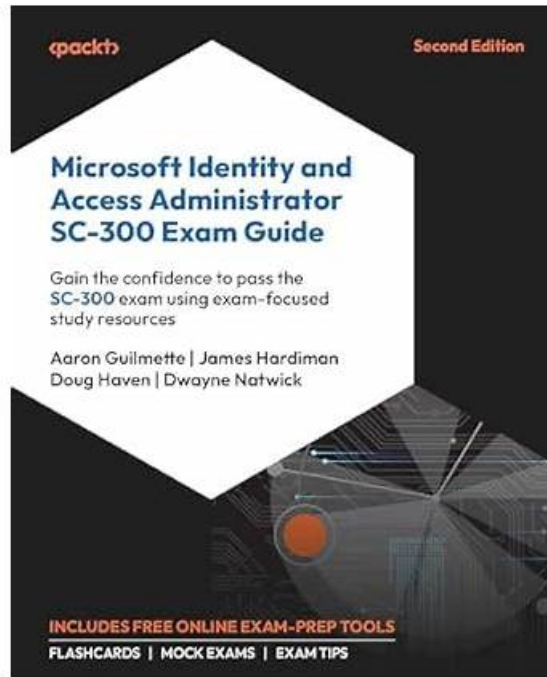

Explanation:

The exhibit shows Pass-through authentication (PTA) enabled with two agents and Password Hash Sync (PHS) enabled. SC-300 materials state that when both PTA and PHS are enabled, Azure AD can fall back to password hash verification if PTA agents are unavailable. With connectivity from on-premises to the Internet lost, PTA agents cannot validate passwords; however, PHS continues to allow cloud authentication for synchronized users. Therefore:

\* User1 (cloud-only) authenticates in Azure AD directly, unaffected by on-prem connectivity.

\* User2 (directory-synced) can still sign in because PHS is enabled and provides backup authentication when PTA is unreachable.

\* User3 (guest) authenticates in the home tenant, which is independent of your on-prem connectivity; the host tenant simply relies on the external identity.

SC-300 explicitly teaches that enabling PHS alongside PTA provides resiliency for sign-in and is a recommended best practice. Consequently, all three users can sign in under the described outage.

User2 responded "No" on January 20, 2021, within the active review window (January 15-29). After submitting, responses are locked. User2 cannot answer again unless the review is restarted.

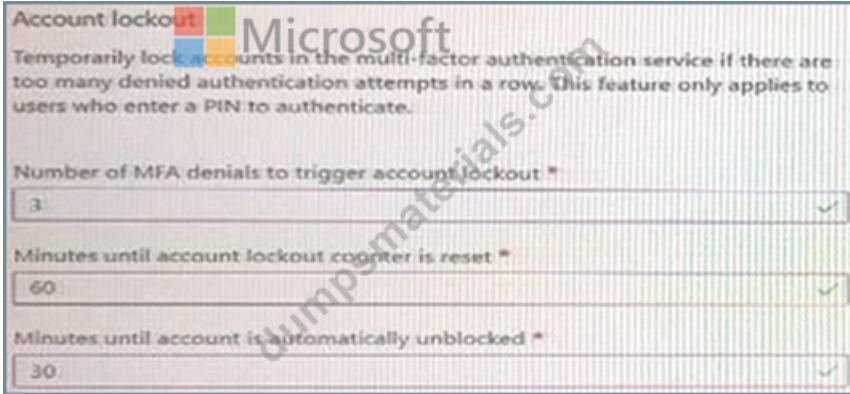
3# # On January 22, 2021, User3 can answer the Review1 question:

The review is configured for Members (self), meaning only group members (User1 and User2) can attest their access. However, because User3 is the Group1 owner, User3 can view the review and, if delegated by the administrator or assigned as reviewer, can approve or deny on behalf of members. Since the exhibit shows the review open and ongoing (January 15-29) and User3 is the

group owner, they can participate in overseeing it.

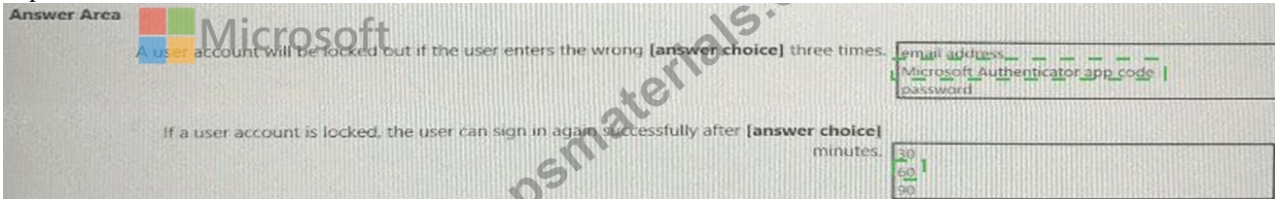

From the exhibit:

- \* Number of MFA denials to trigger account lockout: 3
- \* Minutes until account lockout counter is reset: 60
- \* Minutes until account is automatically unblocked: 30

1. Lockout trigger type:

The lockout applies to MFA denials - specifically, failed verification attempts using methods such as the Microsoft Authenticator app (OTP code) or phone call verification. It does not apply to incorrect usernames or passwords, as those are handled by Azure AD sign-in risk policies.

The official Microsoft documentation states:

"Account lockout in Azure AD Multi-Factor Authentication occurs after the configured number of denied MFA verification attempts. This setting applies to users entering an incorrect PIN or app verification code." Therefore, after three incorrect Microsoft Authenticator app codes, the account is temporarily locked.

2. Lockout duration:

The setting "Minutes until account is automatically unblocked: 30" means that once an account is locked due to too many failed MFA attempts, it will automatically unlock after 30 minutes without administrator intervention.

This aligns with Microsoft's MFA service behavior:

"When the account lockout threshold is reached, the account remains locked for the configured duration before being automatically unlocked."
