Explanation:

Creating a 'SECURE VIEW' is essential. A secure view hides the underlying data and implementation details from the consumer. The 'OR REPLACE' clause ensures idempotency. Granting only 'SELECT' is the principle of least privilege. Secure views ensure data security and integrity while working within the constraints of MANAGED ACCESS. Option A, missing the SECURE keyword, doesn't hide the underlying data. C and D have grant all, which goes against least privilege. E, while attempting to add more security with REVOKE ALL, is unnecessary given the 'WITH MANAGED ACCESS' property. B is the most secure and appropriate solution.

The consumer's Snowflake edition might not support all privileges (but the error would be slightly different), SNOWFLAKE.APP INSTALLER role does not exist, regional difference does not matter as such if provider created version after granting the privileges. The application's role in provider account needs required permission using GRANT ON ACCOUNT TO APPLICATION ROLE.
