 The VMware Cloud Foundation Administrator (2V0-17.25) exam, which leads to VMware Certified Professional – VMware Cloud Foundation Administrator certification (VCP-VCF Administrator), is a 60-item exam with a passing score of 300 using a scaled method. Candidates are given an appointment time of 135 minutes, which includes adequate time to complete the exam for non-native English speakers.

Minimally Qualified Candidate
 The candidate has the knowledge to install, configure, manage, and perform basic troubleshooting of a VMware Cloud Foundation (VCF) solution. The candidate is knowledgeable in the features, functions, and architecture of VCF and its components, including vCenter, ESX, vSphere Supervisor, vSAN, NSX, VCF Identity Broker, VCF Automation, VCF Operations, VCF Operations for Logs, VCF Fleet Management, VCF Operations for Networks, and VCF Operations HCK.

The candidate should have a minimum of one year experience working in IT and should have a foundational knowledge in general enterprise IT topics including, but not limited to, hardware, storage, networking, DNS, NTP and certificates. In addition, the candidate should have at least six months of experience working with either VCF or the individual VCF components. The candidate may occasionally need to research advanced VCF topics (such as command line utilities) or request assistance to troubleshoot complex scenarios. The candidate possesses most of the knowledge shown in the exam sections in the exam blueprint.

Topic 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> IT Architectures, Technologies, Standards: This section of the exam measures the skills of Cloud Architects and focuses on understanding the broader context of IT architectures, common technologies, and industry standards. While it does not have testable objectives, it sets the foundation for how VMware Cloud Foundation aligns with enterprise cloud strategies.
Topic 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plan and Design the VMware by Broadcom Solution: This section of the exam measures the skills of Solution Designers and emphasizes the ability to plan and design VMware by Broadcom solutions. Although no testable objectives are defined here, it reinforces the importance of architectural planning and design considerations for large-scale cloud deployments.

Topic 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> VMware Cloud Foundation Fundamentals: This section of the exam measures the skills of Private Cloud Engineers and covers the basic building blocks of VMware Cloud Foundation. It includes the vision and use cases for private cloud, along with the value it provides to businesses. Candidates are expected to understand compute fundamentals such as deploying and managing vCenter, ESXi, clusters, and virtual machines. Storage fundamentals include configuring vSphere storage, setting up vSAN clusters, applying storage policies, and understanding resilience options. Networking fundamentals are also assessed, with a focus on configuring connectivity, fabrics, routing, and network services in a VMware environment.
Topic 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deploy, Configure, and Operate VMware Cloud Foundation (VCF): This section of the exam measures the skills of VCF Administrators and goes in-depth into deploying, configuring, and managing VMware Cloud Foundation. The deployment portion covers identifying deployment models, configuring private cloud environments, and setting up workload domains and networking. The management objectives focus on lifecycle operations such as fleet management, identity and role-based access, licensing, certificate handling, and importing existing vCenters. Operations are assessed through capabilities like monitoring health, logs, networks, and storage, along with creating dashboards, configuring alerts, and ensuring compliance. The automation portion evaluates skills in using VCF Automation for multi-tenancy, provider networking, content libraries, governance policies, and extensibility to automate business processes. It also includes knowledge of deploying Supervisor-based services within Cloud Foundation.

Which tool can be used to backup and restore workloads on clusters provisioned by vSphere Supervisor?

- A. VMware Live Recovery
- **B. Velero**
- C. Restic
- D. Site Recovery Manager

Answer: B

Explanation:

VMware Cloud Foundation 9.0 documentation for vSphere Supervisor and Kubernetes workload management specifies that Kubernetes-native backup and restore for Supervisor-provisioned clusters is performed using Velero.

From the VCF 9.0 documentation covering Supervisor Services and Kubernetes workload protection:

"For backup and restore of Kubernetes workloads deployed on clusters enabled with vSphere Supervisor, VMware supports the use of Velero to protect Kubernetes resources and persistent volumes." Velero is Kubernetes-native and integrates with the Supervisor cluster to protect:

Namespaces

Kubernetes objects

Persistent volumes

TKG clusters

The other options are incorrect for this use case:

Site Recovery Manager (now part of VMware Live Site Recovery) protects vSphere VMs at the infrastructure level, not Kubernetes objects.

Restic is a backup utility used by Velero internally but is not the primary supported platform tool.

VMware Live Recovery is used for disaster recovery at the VM/site level, not Kubernetes-native backup inside Supervisor.

Using only 2 vCPUs (B) can severely limit performance in medium-to-large environments.

Secure log transfer (A), least-privilege RBAC (C), and robust change management (D) align with common compliance frameworks. Disabling logs (B) contradicts audit requirements.

An administrator logged into NSX Manager to view host details. The administrator noticed that the "Tunnel" status for the ESXi hosts, in the VI workload domain, is showing down. What is a possible reason the ESXi host tunnels are showing down in NSX?

- A. The IGMP has been disabled on the network.
- B. The MTU setting for the host TEPs has been set to 1500.
- C. The overlay traffic is being blocked by the gateway firewall.
- D. The host TEP IP addresses are being dynamically assigned through DHCP instead of being statically assigned.

Answer: B

Explanation:

The "Tunnel" status in NSX indicates the status of the VXLAN tunnels used for communication between ESXi hosts. If the MTU setting for the host Tunnel Endpoint (TEP) is incorrectly set to 1500, this can cause issues with VXLAN encapsulation, as VXLAN packets typically require an MTU of at least 1600 bytes to function correctly. Setting the MTU too low can cause packet drops and result in the tunnel status being down.
