

Options B (gentrification), C (displacement), and D (sub-prime lending) are incorrect: gentrification involves neighborhood revitalization often leading to displacement, which is a later phenomenon; displacement is an outcome, not a policy; and sub-prime lending refers to high-risk loans, a more modern practice.
