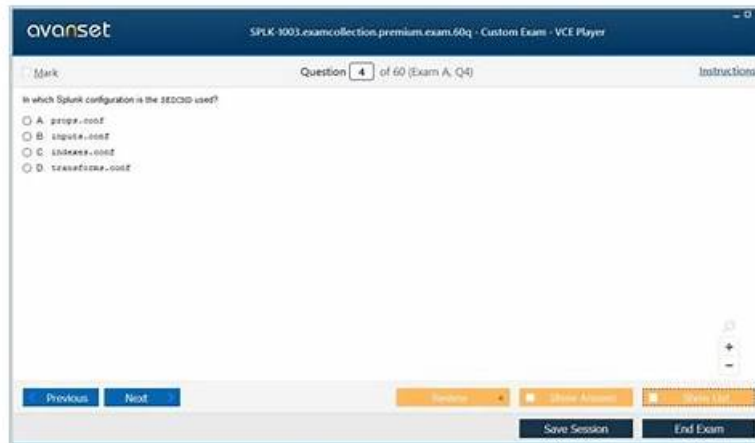

\* The asterisk wildcard matches anything in that specific folder path segment.

Unlike ..., \* does not recurse through subfolders.
