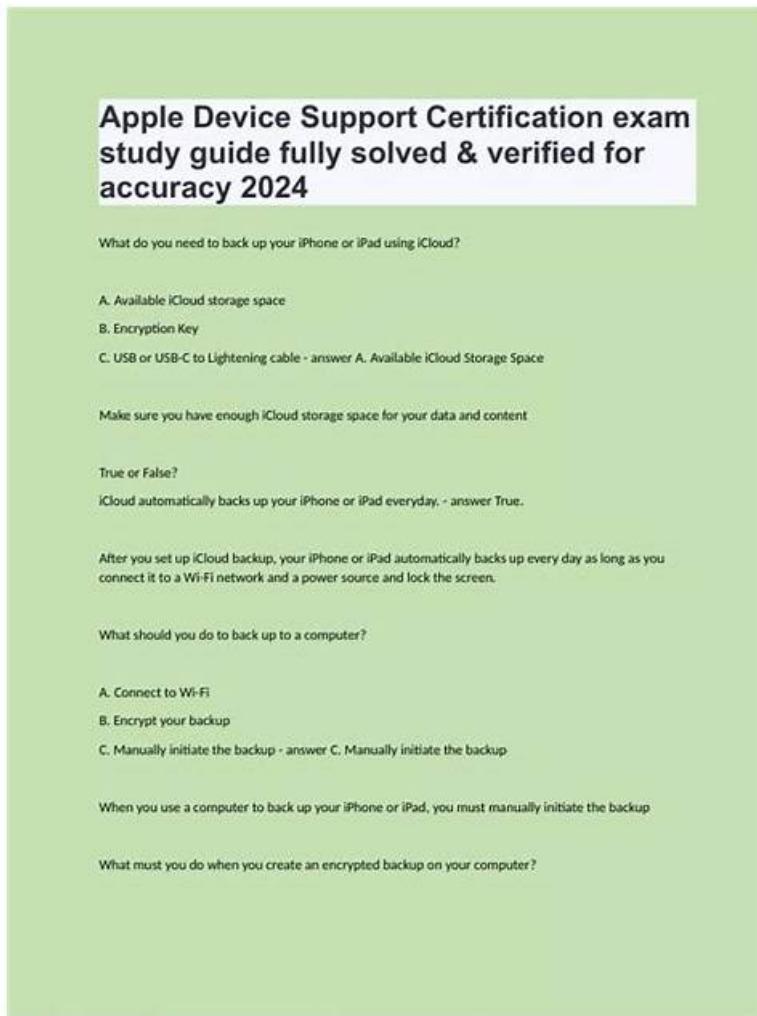

This is because you need to verify your identity with both your password and a verification code that is sent to a device or phone number that only you have access to¹.
