A normal direct pupillary response is brisk constriction of the pupil followed by dilation when a bright light is shone directly into one eye, and a consensual pupillary response is when the opposite eye constricts then dilates similarly to the eye being tested. Assessing both of these responses provides information about which cranial nerve (optic or oculomotor, left or right) is affected. The oculomotor nerve is responsible for extraocular eye movements, as well as contraction of the iris in response to light. The trochlear nerve (cranial nerve IV) is responsible for eye movement down and toward the nose, and Cranial nerve VI (abducens) is responsible for lateral eye movement.
