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A Review of the Applications of CFRP Reinforcements in Civil Engineering

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Abstract. Carbon fiber reinforced polymer (CFRP), as an advanced composite material, has been attracting a great deal of attention from researchers because of its excellent mechanical properties and durability. CFRP reinforcements are increasingly used in the construction and strengthening engineering. In recent years, considering the application of CFRP reinforcements in civil engineering has entered a stage of rapid development, it is necessary to review the development and recent advances in civil engineering. The present paper reviews the applications of CFRP reinforcements in civil engineering, the characteristics and types of CFRP reinforcements and cables, as well as the anchoring system of CFRP cables, are summarized. Furthermore, the applications of CFRP reinforcements and cables in the construction and strengthening engineering are reviewed, especially the developments and applications in bridge engineering. The main goal of this research is to provide a comprehensive review of the application development of CFRP reinforcements in engineering structures. Moreover, the critical issues should be solved for expanding the application scope of them are discussed.

1 Introduction

CFRP is composed of carbon fiber and polymer matrix materials (such as epoxy resin, polyester, nylon resin, etc.), where carbon fiber provides ultra-high strength and high elastic modulus, and the polymer matrix plays a role in bonding, stress transmission, and protecting carbon fiber. CFRP has shown enormous potential in a variety of engineering fields [1].

CFRP was first used in the aerospace field in the 1960s [2]. For the past few years, manufacturing technology has developed rapidly, material technology is constantly advancing, and material costs have also been continuously optimized. These factors have contributed to the gradual expansion of the engineering application scope of CFRP. At present, CFRP has been studied and applied in the fields of automobile manufacturing, ships and submarines, equipment, and construction engineering.

In recent years, with the deepening of research on CFRP and the improvement of production processes, the applications of CFRP cables have gradually increased. CFRP cables can obviously improve the carrying capacity, enhance the durability and seismic performance of structures. Furthermore, compared with steel reinforcements, there are relatively lower carbon emissions of CFRP reinforcements for bridges [3], and also better recycling performance, for instance, the recycled CFRP can be used in the automotive industry [4]. Therefore, CFRP is more environmentally friendly and sustainable, has been extensively applied in engineering.

2 Material properties of CFRP

2.1 Material properties of FRP reinforcements

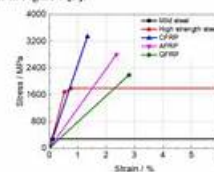


Fig. 1. Strength comparison among FRP reinforcements and steel reinforcements [5].

The commonly used FRP reinforcements include AFRP, GFRP, and CFRP reinforcement. CFRP has the characteristics of ultra-high strength, excellent creep performance, and low relaxation, but the cost is relatively high. The comparison of mechanical properties among these FRP reinforcements and steel reinforcements is shown in Figure 1 [5].

2.2 Characteristics of CFRP cable

In comparison to traditional cables, CFRP cables have broader application prospects with the characteristics of ultrahigh strength under tensile load, and low weight to
