### NEW QUESTION # 148

Oral sucrose is given to infants

- A. for pain relief
- B. to increase heart rate and blood pressure
- C. to treat hypoglycemia

**Answer: A**

Explanation:

Oral sucrose has been used in infants as a mild analgesic. It is given before minor procedures to help relax the infant and provide pain relief. The sucrose solution activates the body's mechanism to produce natural opioid-like substances, such as endorphins. Oral sucrose is not indicated in hypoglycemia or for heart rate and blood pressure control.

### NEW QUESTION # 149

An infant in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit is receiving carbamazepine (Tegretol) for seizure control. When would be the best time to obtain a blood sample to check a drug level?

Explanation:

There are some medications that require drug levels be drawn to ensure the drug concentration is at a therapeutic level and not too high or too low. For carbamazepine (Tegretol), the best time to check the drug level is just prior to giving a dose. The therapeutic drug level for this medication is 4-12 mg/L.

Explanation:

Fetal fibronectin is a protein that helps to keep the amniotic sac adhered to the wall of the uterus. This substance begins to break down towards the end of the pregnancy. If fetal fibronectin is present, it can be a sign that there is an increased risk for preterm labor.

Explanation:

PDA is an opening between the pulmonary and aortic arteries. Before a baby is born, its blood is oxygenated by the mother through the placenta. A vessel is formed connecting the pulmonary and aortic arteries, the ductus arteriosus. Shortly after birth, this vessel closes off so that the infant's blood can then receive oxygen from its own lungs. With a PDA the ductus arteriosus remains open and oxygen-rich blood from the aorta mixes with the blood lacking oxygen from the pulmonary artery. If the rest of the heart is functioning normal, the baby is monitored and the PDA is allowed to repair itself. If this does not happen, the defect can be surgically corrected.

Milia are very common and occur when flakes of skin become trapped within pores. It is most common in newborns and occurs most often on the nose and chin. It is important to not pick or pinch these lesions because this could damage the tissue or lead to a skin infection. The lesions usually resolve on their own within a few weeks.
