IsNotEmpty: Ensures that the field is not empty.

EndsWithUSA: Checks if the extracted address ends with "USA".

ContainsNY: Ensures that the extracted address contains "NY".

The address extracted in this case is: "42 W 80th St. West New York, NJ 1234, USA". While the address ends with "USA"

(passing the EndsWithUSA rule), it includes "West New York, NJ", which satisfies the ContainsNY rule even though "NY" is part of "New York". However, the exact behavior of the Contains rule can generate a warning message because "NY" is part of a larger string ("New York"). Since this does not constitute an error but simply a rule conflict, the validation can proceed. Therefore, the most accurate outcome would be a warning, but validation can still be performed
