Following ABCBS's closure, the National Sheriffs' Association in conjunction with the Global Society of Homeland and National Security Professionals (NSA/GSHNP) offered to convert ABCBS Homeland Security Certifications to either Certified Homeland Protection Associate (CHPA), consisting of levels I to IV, or Certified Homeland Protection Professional (CHPP). To convert a certification, applicants must complete a certification application, submit documentation showing present CHS Certification Level and other applicable documents, along with a request to convert to an NSA/GSHNP Certification, and pay a fee associated with the level of certification achieved. If you hadn't previously received one of these certifications from the ABCBS, you can apply at the GSHNP website.

The objective for the security professional is to leverage longstanding widely accepted concepts and tailor them to the particular situation at hand to best meet the identified protection objectives. All this must be done within the constraints of cost time space culture regulations and operational needs. It is a challenge indeed and this book is meant as a resource to help lay the groundwork for successful physical security projects in every situation. Each of the book's four sections offers practical real-world tools for planning and implementing physical security in contemporary society.

* 3 column pours = $28 \times 3 = 84$ lifts $\times 3 = 252$ lifts

* Additional lifts = 150

* Total lifts = $84 + 150 = 234$ lifts

Lifts Per Day with One Crane:

* 1 crane performs 30 lifts per day.

Required Duration:

* Minimum planned working duration = $\lceil 234 / 30 \rceil = 8$ days

Verification with PSP Guidelines:

Aligning workload with equipment capacity ensures practical schedule planning (Ref. PSP Study Guide, Chapter 2B: Workload Balancing).
