

Function 4: Although a Primary Activity, this function is not well-organised. It relies on trust-based relationships rather than formal contracts. Information is shared informally. It is responsible for warehousing and transportation. #Correct Answer: Outbound Logistics|Social

Function 5: This function has a one-sided supply network. It is a Primary Activity and deals directly with customers. #Correct Answer: Marketing and Sales|Asymmetrical
