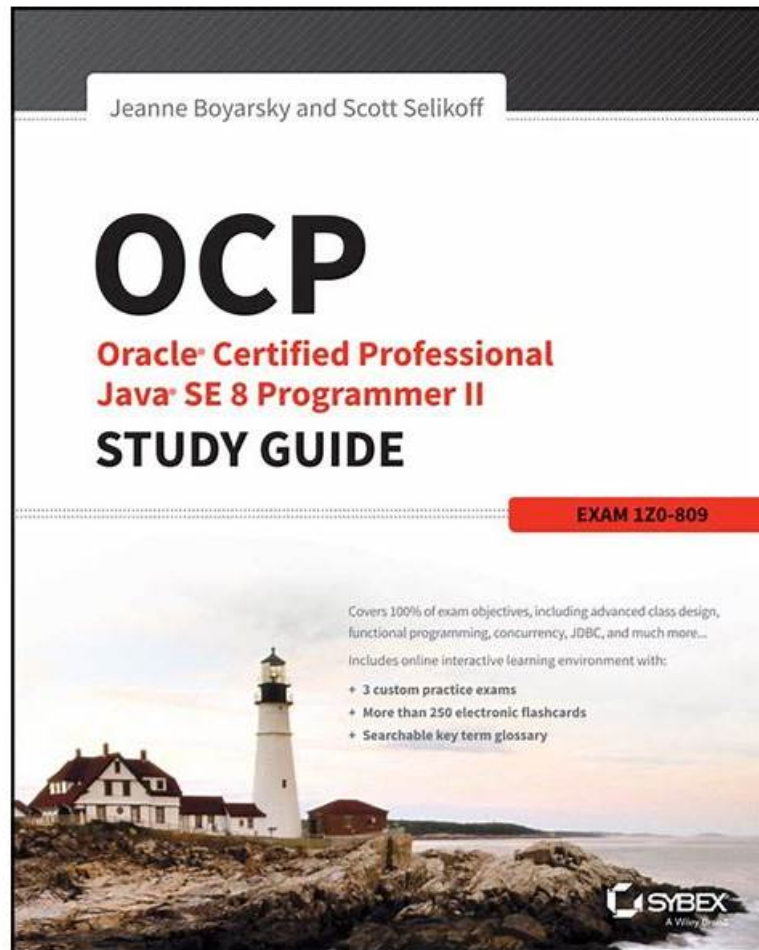


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Oracle Java SE 8 Programmer II Sample Questions (Q35-Q40):

NEW QUESTION # 35

Given:

```
interface Interface1 {
    public default void sayHi() {
        System.out.println("Hi Interface-1");
    }
}

interface Interface2 {
    public default void sayHi() {
        System.out.println("Hi Interface-2");
    }
}

public class MyClass implements Interface1, Interface2 {
    public static void main(String[] args) {
        Interface1 obj = new MyClass();
        obj.sayHi();
    }
    public void sayHi() {
        System.out.println("Hi MyClass");
    }
}
```

What is the result?

- A. Hi MyClass
- B. A compilation error occurs.
- C. Hi Interface-1
- D. Hi Interface-2

Answer: A

NEW QUESTION # 36

Given the code fragment:

```
List<String> li = Arrays.asList("Java", "J2EE", "J2ME", "JSTL", "JSP", "Oracle DB");
Predicate<String> val = p -> p.contains("J");
List<String> neLi = li.stream().filter(x -> x.length() > 3)
    .filter(val).collect(Collectors.toList());
System.out.println(neLi);
```

What is the result?

- A. null
- B. [Java, J2EE, J2ME, JSTL]
- C. [Java, J2EE, J2ME, JSTL, JSP]
- D. A compilation error occurs.

Answer: B

NEW QUESTION # 37

Given:

```
class UserException extends Exception {}
class AgeOutOfLimitException extends UserException {}
```

and the code fragment:

```
class App {
    public void doRegister(String name, int age)
        throws UserException, AgeOutOfLimitException {
        if (name.length() < 6) {
            throw new UserException();
        } else if (age >= 60) {
            throw new AgeOutOfLimitException();
        }
    }
}
```

```

    } else {
    System.out.println("User is registered.");
    }
    }
    public static void main(String[] args) throws UserException {
    App t = new App ();
    t.doRegister("Mathew", 60);
    }
    }
    }

```

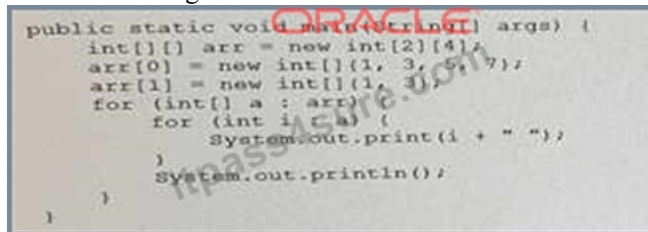
What is the result?

- A. User is registered.
- B. A compilation error occurs in the main method.

NEW QUESTION # 38

Given the code fragment:



```

public static void main(String[] args) {
    int[] arr = new int[2][4];
    arr[0] = new int[] {1, 3, 5, 7};
    arr[1] = new int[] {1, 3};
    for (int[] a : arr) {
        for (int i : a) {
            System.out.print(i + " ");
        }
        System.out.println();
    }
}

```

What is the result?

- A. 1 3
1 3 0 0
- B. 1 3
followed by an ArrayIndexOutOfBoundsException
- C. 1 3 5 7
1 3
- D. 1 3
1 3
- E. Compilation fails.

Answer: C

NEW QUESTION # 39

Given:

```

class CheckClass {
    public static int checkValue (String s1, String s2) {
    return s1.length() - s2.length();
    }
}

```

and the code fragment:

```

String[] strArray = new String [] {"Tiger", "Rat", "Cat", "Lion"}
//line n1
for (String s : strArray) {
    System.out.print (s + " ");
}

```

Which code fragment should be inserted at line n1 to enable the code to print Rat Cat Lion Tiger?

- A. Arrays.sort(strArray, (CheckClass :: new) :: checkValue);
- B. Arrays.sort(strArray, CheckClass :: checkValue);

- Answer: D**

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
