The Supply Chain Operations Reference (SCOR) model is a widely adopted framework for analysing and improving supply chain performance. Additionally, it may not have any direct impact on social or environmental considerations, and could potentially lead to decreased accessibility for consumers.

While it may reduce costs temporarily, it often leads to higher turnover rates and loss of skilled workers. This strategy can have negative social impacts on the workforce and may ultimately harm the company's reputation and long-term sustainability.
