Thema	Einzelheiten
Thema 1	• Process Organization: This section of the exam measures the skills of Process Analysts and covers the structuring of an organization around its processes. It includes defining roles, responsibilities, and governance structures to support a process-centric organizational model.
Thema 2	• Process Design: This section of the exam measures the skills of Business Analysts and covers the creation of optimized process solutions. It includes designing workflows that meet business objectives, incorporating best practices, and ensuring alignment with organizational strategies.
Thema 3	• Process Modeling: This section of the exam measures the skills of Business Analysts and covers techniques for representing business processes visually. It encompasses modeling standards, notations, and tools used to depict current and future state processes for analysis and improvement.
Thema 4	• Process Transformation: This section of the exam measures the skills of Business Analysts and covers strategies for significant process changes. It addresses change management, stakeholder engagement, and approaches to transitioning from current to improved process states.

- **Process Performance Management:** This section of the exam measures the skills of Process Analysts and covers monitoring and evaluating process performance. It focuses on setting performance indicators, analyzing results, and implementing controls to maintain process efficiency and effectiveness.
