

- * Storage utilization is already at70%.
- * RAID-1 (Mirroring):
 - * Each piece of data is mirrored, requiring2x storage capacity.
 - * Space efficiency ~50%.
- * RAID-6 (Erasure Coding FTT=2):
 - * Requires a minimum off6 hosts, satisfied here with 8.
 - * Uses erasure coding instead of full mirroring, giving ~67% space efficiency.
