Slack Connect discoverability must be enabled by an organization for others to search and find them:

It is not about whether you already have a Connect channel (A), or necessarily whether they are on a free plan (B - free plans can still accept Connect invites with some limitations). Option C (turning off Slack Connect entirely) would prevent channel creation but is not specifically why search would fail.

Therefore, even though you sent the channel name from your side, the user on the partner organization side needs to find it by the name assigned in their workspace. It is not an issue of membership (A), posting permissions (C), or privacy settings (B) in this case.

Browser usage alone (Option A) is insufficient for a full Slack experience, and Option D relies too much on user compliance instead of ensuring deployment at scale.
