- * Raises blood pressure (via alpha-1 vasoconstriction)
- * Improves airway tone and reduces mucosal edema

A metered-dose inhaler may help in mild bronchospasm but is insufficient duringanaphylactic shock.

Positive pressure ventilations are a secondary measure if respiratory failure occurs. Nitroglycerin is contraindicated due to low BP. References:
