Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) - ANSWER - A document that stipulates restrictions and practices that a user must agree in order to use organizational computing and network resources.

Advanced Persistent Threat (APT) - ANSWER - A network attack in which an intruder gains access to a network and stays there--undetected--with the intention of stealing data over a long period of time (weeks/ even months)

Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights (TRIPS) - ANSWER - An agreement of the World Trade Organization that requires member governments to ensure that intellectual property rights can be enforced under their laws and that penalties for infringement are tough enough to deter further violations.

Anonymous Expression - ANSWER - The expression of opinions by people who do not reveal their identity.
